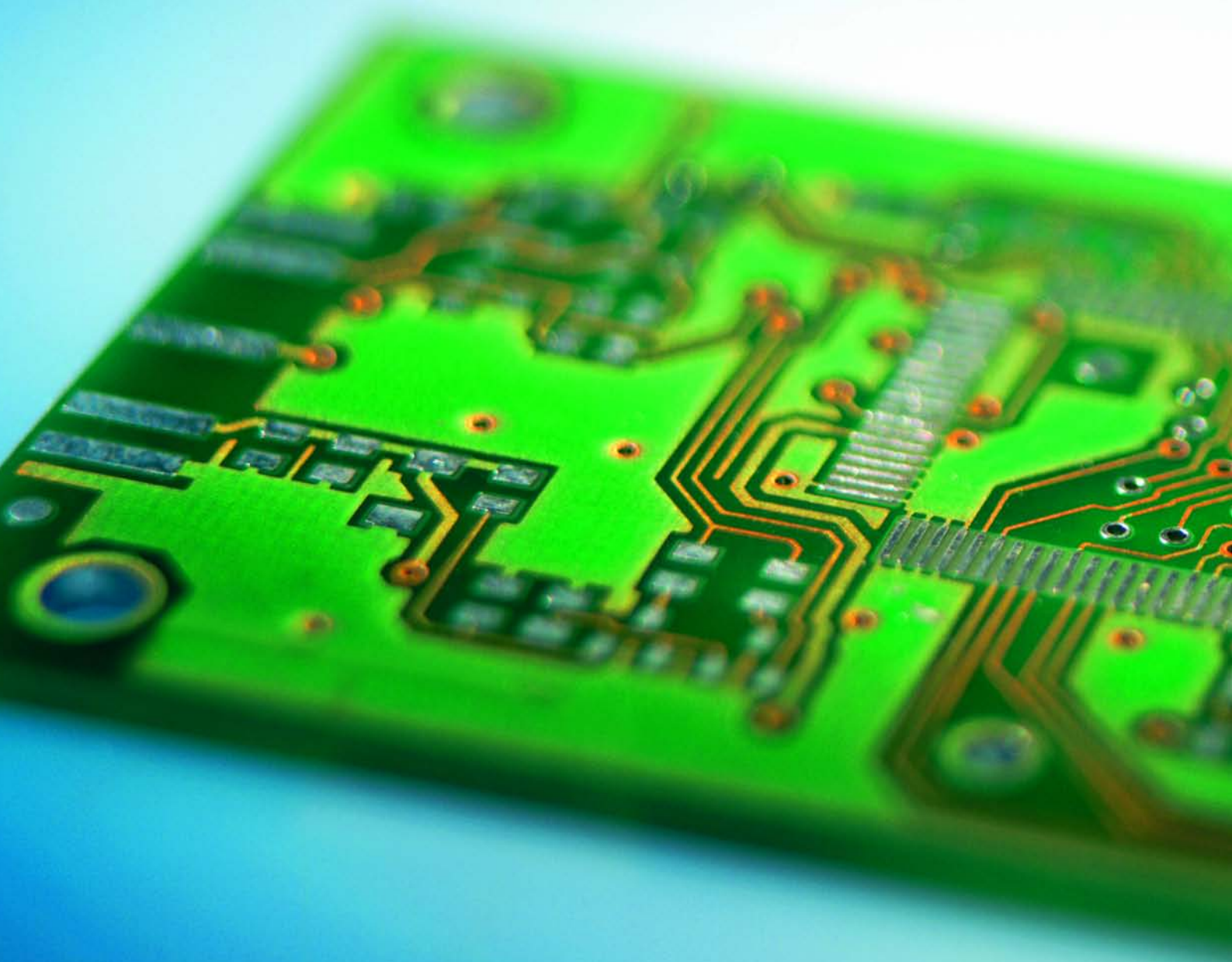

Installations range from small boardroom facilities to huge multi-national convention centres accommodating thousands of delegates. There are now many hundreds of Auditel systems in use in over 60 different countries around the world.

As an equipment manufacturer, Auditel is committed to delivering exactly what the customer requires. Auditel has recently introduced a new economy range of equipment, designed to complement the existing product range. This is known as the 'Envoy' system. This no compromise portable, or flush-mounted solution incorporates a high quality microphone and loudspeaker, with three way voting facilities as standard.

Auditel also offer a unique bespoke manufacturing service capable of integrating features such as security cards, CCTV cameras, delegate text messaging and full biometric authentication. Custom designed delegate panels range from discrete fixtures for listed buildings and council chambers, to opulent, gold plated panels for Middle East customers.

Auditel provide a range of complementary conference services that include maintenance agreements, meeting support and digital recording solutions. These services are designed to fulfill an increasing demand for more sophisticated, feature rich conference facilities.



conference and voting systems

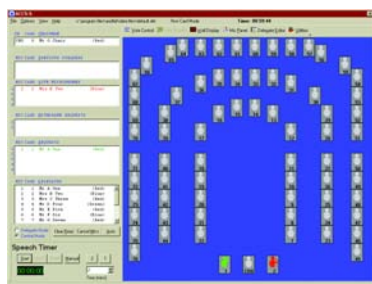
Auditel conference equipment ranges from the small, portable or flush-mounted 'Envoy' entry level system, to systems that have almost limitless scalability supporting delegates in the thousands.

The conference systems are controlled using a four zone central control unit, powering up to 100 units connected in a bus-powered, daisy-chain configuration. Additional auxiliary power units are used when more than 100 delegate units are required.

Greater functionality can be achieved by using Auditel's powerful ACCS Windows® based software. Unlike some systems, only one PC is required to manage an Auditel conference facility, regardless of the amount of delegate units supported.

Auditel conference systems have two operational modes, the first being the push-to-speak 'Delegate' mode. This allows up to 14 delegates to speak simultaneously. In this mode a chairman/operator is not necessary, but can be implemented if required. The second 'Operator' mode offers a number of additional features. These

include controlled queuing, name handling and advanced voting facilities (Auditel ACCS software required).



Up to 16 video cameras can be integrated into any Auditel conference system, each one capable of panning to 100 pre-set positions to display delegates as they speak. Footage from these cameras can be displayed using either a projector and screen, or large format plasma displays. Broadcast quality cameras offering live television coverage have also been integrated into Auditel systems.

Auditel is renowned for its custom integration of conference equipment into existing customer facilities. Many systems have been developed to precise customer specification, from the number of voting buttons to integrating delegate LCD messaging. Total security can be achieved by combining ID card readers with fingerprint authentication sensors. This fail safe method can be used to irradicate any unauthorized voting during parliamentary proceedings.

Unique to Auditel, these customised systems can be installed into any type of conference or parliamentary venue.



Auditel conference and interpretation equipment can be custom built to facilitate any modern modular configuration, through to unobtrusive, sympathetic designs required to be in-keeping with listed buildings.

Auditel systems have been installed in some of the most opulent, palatial buildings in the world, such as the Bayan Palace, the Arab Organization headquarters in Kuwait, and the Golden Pyramid Project in Cairo.

simultaneous interpretation equipment

Designed for bi-lingual or multi-lingual conference facilities, the Lingua FM infrared distribution system provides wireless simultaneous interpretation for up to 32 different languages.

Lingua system features:

- delegate unit powers down when headphones are removed or signal ceases
- signal doesn't penetrate walls, offering greater security
- special charging rack eliminates the need to remove batteries
- emitter panels are four times more powerful than other makes, covering up to 9,500 sq.metres each
- works with other congress systems (IEC 914 and IEC 61603-3 compliant)



The Lingua delegate unit sits comfortably in one hand and has a belt clip, slips into a shirt pocket, or can be worn around the neck using a lanyard. Different channels are selected by scrolling through the menu displayed on the LCD display. The Lingua is also suitable for distributing high quality wireless multichannel audio such as soundtracks in cinemas, museums, and places of worship.

Interpreter consoles

Auditel manufacture three types of Interpreter console, designed for use in conference interpretation booths. The BLIP-2D is used when only two languages are required. It is a dual unit with individual controls for each interpreter plus "passive" headphone monitoring facilities for an observer. The IP6D/2 is a cost effective six channel, dual control system that eliminates the need for two units per booth. This makes interpreter change overs simple and smooth. The IP-12/2 is designed to control up to twelve interpreted languages simultaneously.



All of these consoles are self-contained, comply with international standards, and can be used in conjunction with most makes of microphone and language distribution systems.

Auditel were the first to pioneer camera integration into conference systems, with the first such installation at Bayan Palace Kuwait in 1986. Up until then, preset camera positioning had not been achieved with pan tilt zoom, broadcast quality cameras. Auditel were also the first to integrate conference equipment with finger print identification at the Mexican Parliament. Auditel also produced the first ever conference touchscreen control system at the Irish Parliament in Dublin.



As new technologies are introduced, such as e-democracy, Auditel continue to be at the forefront of conference applications. At the Welsh Assembly for instance, web streaming from Auditel equipment has been introduced, which allows the general public to view parliamentary debates live over an internet broadband connection.

Auditel installation examples

Westminster City Council - London

The council of London's most well known district chose Auditel equipment when they sought to modernise the existing council chambers. The chambers, situated in historic listed buildings, were fitted with a chairman and 74 fixed delegate units with voting facilities, and a full audio visual system that includes automated CCTV cameras, two large format plasma screens, DVD archiving and webcasting capabilities.

Welsh National Assembly - Wales

Auditel was chosen by the National Assembly for Wales to supply computer controlled, bi-lingual conference equipment with microphone, voting and delegate card reading facilities. The conference computer was integrated with broadcast camera control equipment and caption control systems, to provide details of each member speaking. Once voting results have been collated, they are copied to the Assembly's server for use by member services over an intranet and extranet. Meetings can be viewed and listened to online via the Assembly website.

2004 Olympics Main Press Centre - Greece

Highly prestigious contract to supply a multi-lingual conference system to the 2004 Olympic Games in Athens. The Games Main Press Centre (MPC) was installed with 800 customised units, incorporating microphone, electronic voting, language selector and identity card reader, and featured equipment for 12 interpreter booths and 11 CCTV cameras, all controlled automatically by the Auditel central system computer running ACCS software.

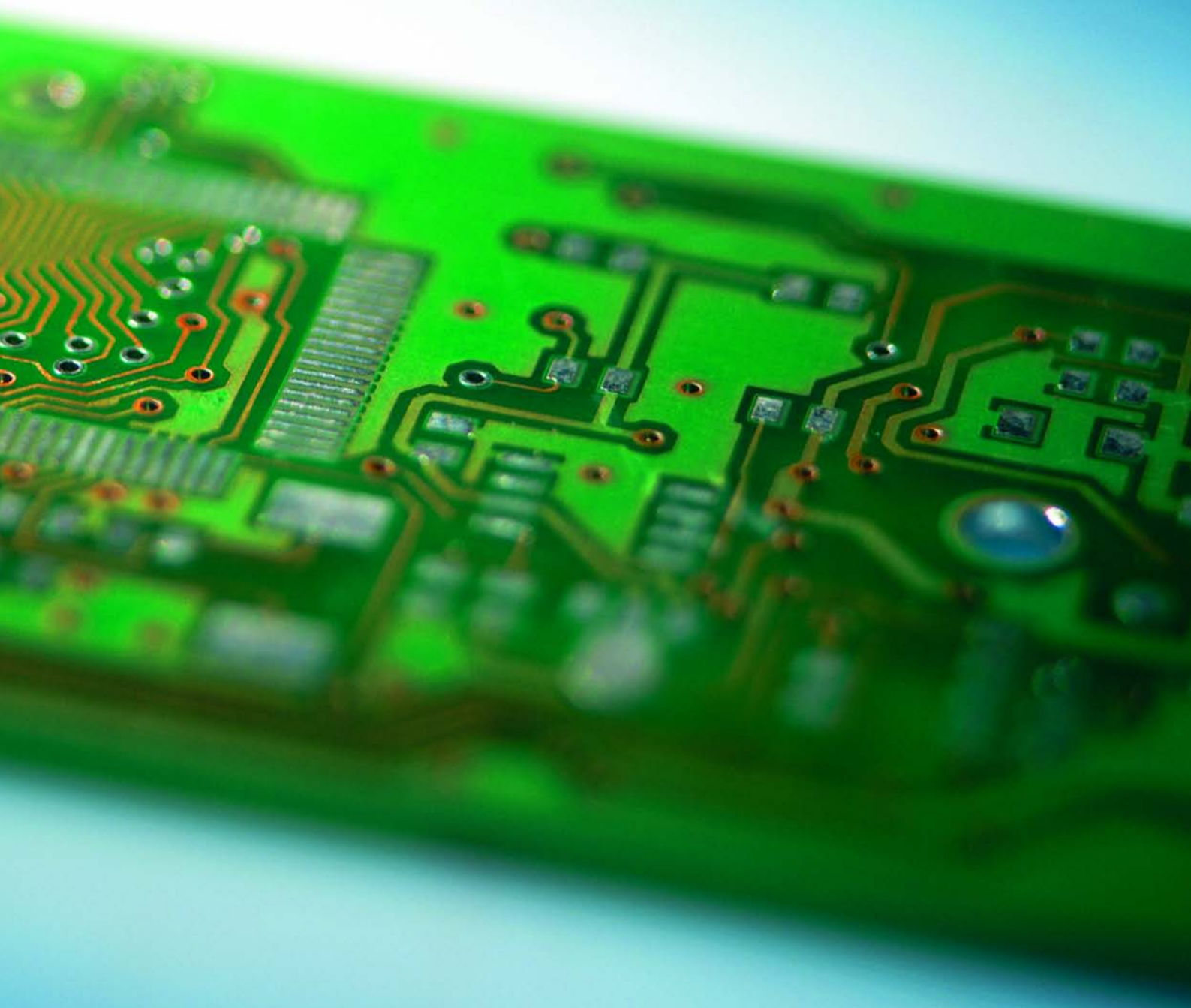
Vinci International Convention Centre - France

The Vinci International Conference Centre optimises adaptability, flexibility and functionality, whilst integrating seamlessly into the historic French surroundings. Europe's leading conference venue, the Vinci has been fully equipped with Auditel conference and interpretation systems, which facilitate sound reinforcement for 345 delegates and the simultaneous interpretation of up to four different languages, distributed by wireless infra-red. To meet the centres unusual requirements, Auditel developed a unique portable delegate seat-arm unit, with easy detachment when not in use.

Bayan Palace Conference Centre - Kuwait

Auditel systems were installed throughout this luxuriant complex including the main conference building. This comprised of a conference hall and an auditorium with a seating capacity of 1,200. Auditel was also involved in the second phase of this huge redevelopment, which added a Guest Palace and Banquet Hall to the complex.
